Luis Jiménez Mc Innis was appointed Representative for the Office in Europe of the Inter-American Development Bank (IDB) in December 2024.

Prior to this role, he served as Director of the Department of External Relations, Partnerships, and Resource Mobilization at the Pan American Health Organization (PAHO/WHO) from 2022 to 2024.

He has held several prominent leadership positions within various United Nations organizations, including:

- Secretary and Director of the Office of the Secretary (2020–2022),
- Director of the Office of Partnerships and Resource Mobilization (2016–2019), and
- Special Advisor to the President (2010–2015) at the International Fund for Agricultural Development (IFAD), based in Rome, Italy.

Earlier in his career, he served as First Officer in the Executive Office of the UN Secretary-General (2007–2010), and as Political Affairs Officer in the Department of Political Affairs (2000–2007) at the United Nations Secretariat in New York.

He holds a Master's degree in International Affairs from Columbia University and a Bachelor's degree in International Relations and Political Science from Brown University.
